RE: **SNOW REMOVAL – Walkerton Downtown Business Core and Hamlets**

PURPOSE:

The Municipality of Brockton shall establish an appropriate policy for snow removal in the Walkerton Downtown Business Core and in certain areas of the Hamlets of Cargill, Chepstow and Elmwood.

The main objective of this policy is that efforts will be made to keep snow removal from curbs for safety concerns with pedestrian traffic.

It is the policy of the Municipality of Brockton that:

- Snow will be removed from street gutters in the Walkerton downtown business core (map of business core attached) on a weekly basis when accumulations reach 25 cm or more above the curb.
- Snow removal would take place between 2:00 a.m. & 7:00 a.m. – Tuesday to Friday
- During heavy overnight snowfalls and extreme weather conditions, snow would be allowed to accumulate until the storm ended and scheduling could be arranged for snow removal
- During the month of December, priority will be given to the snow removal on Durham Street from McNab to Young.
- Snow from the bridge in Cargill will be pushed back daily by the wing of the plow with complete removal of snow from the bridge when snow exceeds 45 cm in height
- Snow management on the main street in Chepstow will be carried out by making a double round with the snowplow. When snow becomes excessive and creates a safety concern it will be removed.
- Snow in the hamlet of Elmwood will be removed when excessive and creating a safety issue, in co-operation with the Municipality of West Grey
- Removal or displacement of high snow banks that impair visibility or public safety will be monitored throughout the winter season.
