MUNICIPAL ELECTION 2010

On May 31, 2010 Council adopted By-Law 2010-23 to adopt an internet and telephone voting method. In addition to this new method of vote, paper ballots will be made available for those who wish to use them. Three locations are presently planned for the paper ballot on Voting Day **October 25, 2010, only**. Photo ID and PIN numbers will be required. Those using the internet or telephone method will be able to vote 24 hours per day from 8:30 a.m. October 18 until October 25 at 8:00 p.m. More details to follow in later editions of the Brockton Buzz, and on the website. www.brockton.ca Policies and procedures are in place effective June 1, 2010.

AMENDMENT TO TRAFFIC AND PARKING BY-LAW

1. To designate "No Parking" on both sides of McNab Street between Durham St. and Scott St.

Written comments from the public and input from municipal staff will be presented to Brockton Council for their consideration and decision at the Brockton Council meeting of June 14th, 2010.

TIRE RECYCLING ROLLS AT LOCAL LANDFILL SITES

The **Municipality of Brockton** collects **Used Tires** for recycling at the **Brant, Greenock & Hanover-Walkerton** Landfill Sites at NO COST. Maximum **4 Tires/day**. Tires **MUST** be '**OFF RIM**' and **CLEAN**. Tires can be brought to sites **only during regular hours of operation**.

Residents must use their respective landfill site within their municipal border.

ATTENTION SEPTIC TANK OWNERS

The Municipality of Brockton building department will be continuing with a voluntary Septic Re-inspection Program this year. Please don't forget that septic tanks (depending on size of tank and number in family) on average need to be pumped every 3 to 5 years to avoid costly damage to your leaching bed. There are several contractors in the area licensed to do this work. Please call the local building department at 881-2223 to arrange for a free inspection of your tank while your contractor is pumping it out.
