Commercial, Agricultural, Industrial Wastes, or Volumes, PCB's, Infectious, Sharps or Radioactive Wastes will NOT be accepted. To reduce volumes, paints can be combined in one container. Empty paint cans and aerosols are blue box recyclable. Bring gasoline in containers that can be disposed of. Gas cans will not be emptied and returned.

GOODS EXCHANGE WEEK

The Municipality of Brockton will once again have a "Goods Exchange Week" from **Friday May 21st to Friday May 28th, 2010**. This free Municipality wide "sidewalk sale" is a great opportunity for everyone to exchange those reusable household items such as furniture, appliances or children's toys which you no longer use. Just put them at the curb clearly marked that they are free. Any items left at the curb after "Goods Exchange Week" must be removed by the Property Owner and **will not be picked up** by the Municipality.

NEW TAX STATEMENT CHARGE

Effective immediately there will be \$10.00 fee for a tax statement or a re-print of your tax bill.

We have many requests for this service at income tax time or when property owners are selling their homes. Your **final tax bill** shows total taxes billed for the current year and this is the information required by the lawyer or for income tax purposes. If you wish your tax bill stamped paid please send it in with your payment along with a self addressed envelope or bring it in at the time of payment.
