****Remember...Do Not put your child in the bath tub while the water is running****

Children have sensitive skin which can burn easier than an adult’s skin. That is why you should always check the water by putting your hand all the way into the water spreading your fingers and moving your hand back and forth throughout the length of the tub to check for hot spots.
