**Commercial, Agricultural, Industrial wastes, or volumes, PCB's, infectious or radioactive wastes will NOT be accepted.** To reduce volumes, paints can be combined in one container. Empty paint cans and aerosols are blue box recyclable. Bring gasoline in containers (glass jars, etc.) that can be disposed of. Gas cans will not be emptied and returned.

### BALE WRAP COLLECTION DEPOT

Effective July 14<sup>th</sup> 2009 a Bale Wrap Collection Pad for the collection of **WHITE 100% Polyethylene Film** will be operational at the Brant Landfill Site. On July 15<sup>th</sup>, 2009 a collection bin will be available for depositing this material at the Greenock Landfill Site. These facilities are for the depositing of **WHITE 100% Polyethylene Film** rolled into 3 to 5 pound balls.

**Watering Lawns & Gardens**

Municipality of Brockton By-Law #2005-23 states the following;

- Municipal or civic addresses with even numbers shall be permitted to water on even numbered days, but only during the hours of 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 am and 6:00 pm to 9:00 pm.
- Municipal or civic addresses with odd numbers shall be permitted to water on odd numbered days, but only during the hours of 7:00 am to 9:00 am and 6:00 pm to 9:00 pm.
- Municipal or civic addresses that have automatic watering systems shall be permitted to water on any day, but only during the hours of 2:30 am to 6:00 am.



This by-law will be enforced, with the set fine being \$50.00.
