## **OPEN AIR BURNS - BY-LAW 2004-15**

Property Owners having open air fires are subject to By-Law 2004-15. Contraventions can result in a fine under the Provincial Offences Act which can include the full costs of the fire department to extinguish the fire if the fire is not under the control of the property owner
