### **Cargill Community Centre Entranceway for “Community” Project Update**

**Brockton, ON**, October 16, 2019 – The Municipality of Brockton is proud to share an update on the fundraising for the Cargill Community Centre Entranceway for “Community” project. Through the dedication of the Cargill and District Community Fund (CDCF), the current balance owing on the entranceway project is \$131,676.00.

Over three years ago, the need became apparent to address energy inefficiency and accessibility issues at the Cargill Community Centre. A decision was made to replace the outdated portion of the Cargill Community Centre with a newly constructed addition, consisting of an expanded accessible entranceway, larger meeting room, orderly cloak room, and barrier-free washrooms to create a more useful and energy efficient space. The new entranceway opened on June 20, 2019.

The project cost was \$810,000, with the Municipality committing to finance 40% of this project. We congratulate the CDCF, a committee of volunteers, who have diligently financed the remaining \$486,000. Thanks to financial support through donations, fundraisers, grants, and reserve funds, \$354,058 has been raised to date.

The CDCF are continuing the campaign to raise the remaining \$131,676.00. The Municipality and CDCF extend our sincere gratitude to the individuals and companies who have already generously contributed to this project. The CDCF Cargill Community Centre Entranceway Committee are reminding local residents and businesses that there is still time for recognition by supporting this impressive local project in the form of a donation.
