COMMITTEE MEMBERS NEEDED – BROCKTON COMMUNITY LIAISON COMMITTEE

The Municipality of Brockton has expressed interest in learning more about Canada's plan for the long-term management of used nuclear fuel and the process for identifying an informed and willing host community for a deep geological repository.

The municipality has created a Brockton Community Liaison Committee (BCLC) with a mandate to engage, educate and listen to residents of Brockton regarding the NWMO Site Selection Process.

If you would like to be considered for membership on the BCLC, please submit an Expression of Interest to the municipality. The Expression of Interest shall include a summary of skills, experiences and knowledge that you possess and feel would be an asset to the BCLC, the reasons you wish to serve on the BCLC, a summary of your current knowledge of the project and finally what you hope to achieve as a member of the BCLC.

WATERING LAWNS & GARDENS

Municipality of Brockton By-Law #2005-23 states the following;

- Municipal or civic addresses with even numbers shall be permitted to water on even numbered days, but only during the hours of 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 am and 6:00 pm to 9:00 pm.
- Municipal or civic addresses with odd numbers shall be permitted to water on odd numbered days, but only during the hours of 7:00 am to 9:00 am and 6:00 pm to 9:00 pm.
- Municipal or civic addresses that have automatic watering systems shall be permitted to water on any day, but only during the hours of 2:30 am to 6:00 am.



This by-law will be enforced, with the set fine being \$50.00.

NOTICE OF WALKERTON WATERMAIN FLUSHING

As part of the ongoing maintenance of the Walkerton Water System, Veolia Water will be flushing the Walkerton distribution system throughout June and July 2013. This is estimated to take approximately 1 ½ months to complete. Residents are asked to run a cold water tap after the flushing has been completed in your area to discharge any discoloured water before use. We apologize for any inconvenience that this may cause. **BARBECUE SAFETY – brought to you by Mike Murphy, Fire Chief/CEMC**

- Test hoses for leaks (use a 50/50 mixture of soap and water).
- Open the lid before lighting.
- Always barbecue outside.
- Keep children at a safe distance.
- Keep combustibles a safe distance from the barbecue.
- Check for insect nests and spider webs.
- Light match before opening the valve.
- Transport cylinders in an upright position and in a ventilated space.
- Never leave a lit barbecue unattended.
- Always close the barbecue cylinder when finished.
- Follow Manufacturer's Instructions.
