Brockton Household Waste Collection Schedule Changes to BI-WEEKLY Pick-up in September

A reminder to all Brockton residents that Brockton household waste collection returns to a bi-weekly schedule as of September 1, 2015.

Household waste is only collected weekly from May through August. Bi-weekly collection in Brockton begins on the following dates:

Brant Tuesday, September 8

Walkerton West Tuesday, September 8

Walkerton East Wednesday, September 9

Household hazardous and special waste includes, but is not limited to, the following products:

Batteries, Drain Openers,	Pesticides, Pharmaceuticals,	Gasoline, Antifreeze, Paint, Oil,	Aerosols, Pool chemicals, Ammonia,

Cottage Fire Safety

Heading off to the cottage to enjoy the warm weather? Here are some items to keep in mind this year regarding fire safety at your home away from home.

- 1. Just like your home, your cottage or cabin must have a working smoke alarm on every storey and outside sleeping areas. It's the law! Pack a smoke alarm with fresh batteries before heading out.
- 2. Make sure the entrance to the property has a clearly visible sign indicating the property number.
- 3. Many cottages or cabins are heated by wood stoves. Ensure your chimneys are cleaned and inspected annually. Remember to allow ashes from your wood stove or fireplace to cool before emptying them into a <u>metal</u> container with a tight fitting lid. Store your ashes container outside, away from the cottage or any sheds.

Check with the local municipal office or the Ministry of Natural Resources for burning restrictions or by-laws. When a restricted fire zone order is implemented, no outdoor fires are permitted.

Notice of Walkerton Watermain Flushing

As part of the ongoing maintenance of the Walkerton water system, Veolia Water will be flushing the Walkerton distribution system throughout July and August 2015. This is estimated to take about one and a half months to complete. Residents are asked to run a cold water tap after the flushing has been completed in your area to discharge any discoloured water before use. We apologize for any inconvenience that this may cause.
