**2015 Municipal Leaf Collection – Walkerton, Lake Rosalind, Marl Lakes**

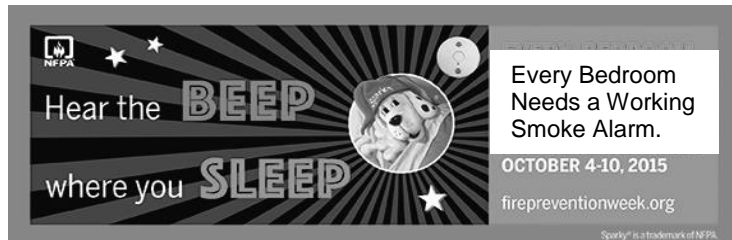
