Brockton Household Waste Collection Schedule Changes to BI-WEEKLY Pick-up in September

A reminder to all Brockton residents that Brockton household waste collection returns to a bi-weekly schedule as of September 1, 2015. **Household waste will NOT be collected on Sept. 1, 2 or 3.**

Household waste is only collected weekly from May through August. Bi-weekly collection in Brockton begins on the following dates:

Amendments to Traffic and Parking By-Law

The Municipality of Brockton is considering amendments to the Traffic and Parking By-Law as follows:

1. Parking is to be restricted on the south side of Napier Street between Yonge and Jackson Street.

Written comments regarding this proposal will be received at the Brockton Municipal Office until Friday September 18, 2015 at 12:00 noon. Written comments from the public and input from municipal staff will be presented to Brockton Council for their consideration and decision at the Brockton Council meeting on September 28, 2015.
