Walkerton Fire Department - Heating Safety

With the cold weather and snowfall we have been experiencing it is important to remember some of the steps we can all take to ensure we heat our homes safely.



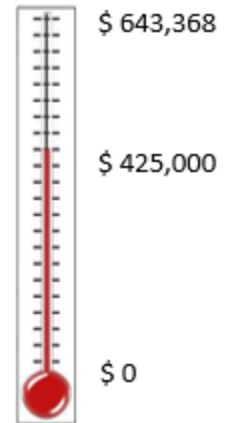
- 1) Have your heating system or fireplace and chimney inspected annually by a qualified technician.
- 2) Give space heaters plenty of space (at least 3 feet) away from anything that can burn, including curtains, upholstery, and clothing.
- 3) Allow the ashes from your woodstove or fireplace to cool before emptying them into a metal container with a tight fitting lid. Keep the container outside.
- 4) Install a Carbon Monoxide (CO) alarm near all bedroom areas to alert you to the presence of deadly carbon monoxide gas.
- 5) Remember to keep snow from accumulating around any vents coming from your house, as well as around fire hydrants that may be next to your property.
