Brockton Garbage/Household Waste Collection Continues WEEKLY Pickup in October

A reminder to all Brockton residents that Brockton household waste collection continues on a WEEKLY schedule as of September 1, 2016 through to October 28, 2016. Beginning November 1, 2016, household waste will return to Bi-Weekly pickup. When Bi-Weekly pickup returns, garbage pickup **will not** be the same week as recycling pickup.
