Holiday Fire Safety

With the Christmas season quickly approaching here are some items to keep in mind this year regarding fire safety for a safe and happy holiday.

- 1) Keep your Tree Fire Free:
 - a) Buy a fresh tree and make sure the base of the tree is immersed in water at all times.
 - b) Keep all candles away from the Christmas tree.
 - c) Check all sets of lights before putting them on the tree. Discard any lights that are damaged.
- 2) Keep candles in a sturdy holder away from children, pets and combustibles. Blow them out before leaving the room. Never leave a candle unattended.
- 3) Alcohol and fire are a dangerous mix. Keep a close eye on anyone attempting to cook or smoke under the influence of alcohol.





- 4) Ensure that your smoke alarms are installed on every floor and outside all sleeping areas. Test your alarms to ensure they are working correctly, remember **only** a working smoke alarm can save lives.
