Meet the NWMO and Learn More about Preliminary Assessment Studies

The Municipality of Brockton has invited the Nuclear Waste Management Organization (NWMO) to host open houses. Drop by, meet NWMO staff, ask questions, and learn more about Canada's plan for the long-term management of used nuclear fuel and the process to identify a safe site to host a deep geological repository. Come out and share your thoughts on the project and the current phase of work including desk-top geoscience studies and community well-being learning now underway. Light refreshments will be provided.

Along with the regular open house, the NWMO is introducing a new **TRANSPORTATION EXHIBIT**. The exhibit provides a hands-on opportunity to learn more about plans for the safe and secure transportation of Canada's used nuclear fuel. The transportation of used nuclear fuel is a stringently regulated activity involving both Transport Canada and the Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC).

Open houses will be held on Thursday, May 15, 2014 1:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. and Friday, May 16, 2014 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. at the Walkerton Community Centre, 290 Durham Street West, Walkerton Ont.
