MUNICIPAL OFFICE AUTOMATED ANSWERING SERVICE

ANIMAL CONTROL – DOG TAGS

The Municipality of Brockton will be **mailing** your dog tag(s) along with an invoice in early January 2014. The tags issued will be based on dog owner information in our current database. Also, these tags will be “**PERMANENT**” tags and commencing January 2015, you will receive an annual invoice only. 2014 fees are as follows:

\$15.00 – First Dog (per household) **\$ 25.00** – Additional Dogs **\$100.00** - Kennel License (more than 3 dogs)
\$10.00 Late Fee – (after Apr.1st) **\$150.00** – Dangerous Dogs **\$ 5.00** – Replacement Tag

Persons with lost dogs are requested to contact the Walkerton-Hanover Vet Clinic (519-881-2090) or the Animal Control Officer, Rick Parker (519-373-5037) to check if these animals are at the municipal pound.

Heating Safety: Have all chimneys cleaned and inspected every year. Have your heating system inspected annually by a qualified service technician. Keep space heaters at least one meter (3 feet) away from anything that can burn, including curtains, upholstery, clothing and people.

Carbon Monoxide Alarms: Make sure you have working carbon monoxide alarms which will alert you to the presence of this deadly gas. Carbon monoxide is an invisible, odorless gas that can quickly kill you. Replace any carbon monoxide alarms over 10 years old.
