2014 Municipal Election Update

Internet and telephone voting will be available from 8:30 a.m. on Monday, October 20, 2014 until 8:00 p.m. on Monday, October 27, 2014. Free internet access and voting kiosks will be available during regular hours at the Brockton Municipal Office and Walkerton and Cargill Library Branches.

On Voting Day, Monday, October 27, 2014, paper ballots can be cast at the Walkerton Branch of the Royal Canadian Legion and a voting kiosk will be available at the Municipal Office from 10:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. You will need your Voter Information Letter to vote electronically or by paper ballot. These letters will be mailed after October 6.

A Voter Help Desk will also be set up to assist electors.

Keep Unaccepted Items out of Yellow Film Plastics Recycling Bins

The response to our Film Plastics Recycling Pilot Project has been overwhelming! Brockton residents have been bagging their film plastics and dropping them off in the yellow film plastics bins at the Walkerton Recycling Depot and Brockton Landfill sites and the bins are starting to fill up.

Unaccepted items are also being placed in the bins. We are asking residents to sort film plastics carefully. Download our [Film Plastics Recycling Pilot Project Flyer](#) (or pick up a copy at the Municipal Office) and post it on your fridge.

Only bags identified by #2 HDPE (high density polyethylene) or #4 LDPE (low density polyethylene) are accepted. All other film plastics must be placed in your regular household garbage. To make this program a success we need your feedback, email info@brockton.ca with comments and suggestions.
