If you are on the Voters List but your information is incorrect:

You will need to complete an Application to Amend Voters List (Form EL15) at the Municipal Office Monday to Friday – 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. located at 100 Scott Street, Walkerton. Please have your photo identification with you.

If you are unable to attend the Municipal Office during regular hours to complete an Application to Amend Voters List, you may do so at the polling station on Election Day, Monday, October 27, 2014 from 4:30 p.m. until 8:00 p.m. Please have your photo identification with you.

Advance polling by internet and telephone will be available from 8:30 a.m. on Monday, October 20 until Monday, October 27 at 8:00 p.m.

A paper polling station will be provided at the Walkerton Legion, 505 Scott Street, Walkerton Ontario for all Wards on Monday, October 27, 2014 from 10:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m.
