**IT'S FIRE PREVENTION WEEK**

**OCTOBER 6<sup>TH</sup> TO OCTOBER 12<sup>TH</sup>**

The theme of Fire Prevention Week is **"Prevent Kitchen Fires"**

- Two of every five home fires start in the kitchen.
- Two-thirds of home cooking fires started with ignition of food or other cooking materials.
- Children under 5 years of age face a higher risk of non-fire burns associated with cooking.
- Unattended cooking was a factor in 34% of reported home cooking fires.
- Ranges accounted for the 58% of home cooking fire incidents. Ovens accounted for 16%.
- Microwave ovens are one of the leading home products associated with scald burn injuries.

The Walkerton Fire Department will be holding a number of events about the importance of cooking safety and working smoke alarms, including an **"Open House" on Wednesday October 9<sup>th</sup> 6:30pm - 8:00pm** at the Walkerton Fire Station, 510 Napier Street, Walkerton.
