

THE CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF BROCKTON

BY-LAW #2007-55

BEING A BY-LAW TO PROHIBIT THE PLACEMENT OF ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT (E-WASTE) AT LANDFILL SITES WITHIN AND OPERATED, WHETHER SINGULARLY OR IN PARTNERSHIP BY THE MUNICIPALITY OF BROCKTON

WHEREAS UNDER Section 9 of the Municipal Act 2001, S.O. 2001 as amended Municipalities are empowered to govern their affairs as they consider appropriate; and

WHEREAS the Council of the Municipality of Brockton deems it expedient to divert and prohibit Electronic Waste (E-Waste) from being placed at landfill sites; and

WHEREAS the Council of the Municipality of Brockton wishes to eliminate the potential for hazardous contaminants entering the Landfill Sites;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Brockton **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. No person shall place Electronic Waste – E-Waste in any landfill site operated singularly or in partnership by the Municipality of Brockton.
2. Electronic Waste – E-Waste shall be disposed of at locations established to receive such waste.
3. Electronic Waste - E-Waste is defined as those materials listed on Schedule “A” attached hereto and forming part of this by-law.
4. Every person who contravenes any provision of this by-law is guilty of an offence and is subject to the penalties under the Provincial Offences Act.
5. That this by-law shall supercede all others.
6. That this by-law shall come into force and effect on September 1, 2007.
