Municipality of Brockton's Update as a Result of Province of Ontario Lifting Additional Restrictions on March 1, 2022

Brockton, ON, March 1, 2022 - The Municipality of Brockton prioritizes the health and well-being of residents and businesses by following advice from the Grey Bruce Health Unit and Provincial Government. As the Province of Ontario enters its next phase of the Reopening Roadmap today, the Municipality of Brockton is implementing the following changes to services:

The Walkerton Community Centre, Cargill Community Centre, and Elmwood Community Centre are open to the public. As of March 1st, vaccination verification is no longer required to enter these facilities, and capacity restrictions have been lifted. Individuals entering the facilities are still required to wear a face covering until further notice. Staff encourage passive self-screening for COVID-19 symptoms.
