Pursuant to Subsection 5.1, of the *Municipal Conflict of Interest Act*, R.S.O. 1990 (In force and effect on March 1, 2019), Council members must complete this form prior to the Council meeting at which they will be making a declaration of pecuniary interest, direct or indirect.
