



## Amendments to Traffic and Parking By-Law

### Purpose:

To allow proposed changes received from members of the public to the municipality's Traffic and Parking By-Law and for circulation of these changes for comment and input prior to receiving confirmation from the municipal Council.

### It is the policy of the Municipality of Brockton that:

- Proposals from members of the public for amendments to the municipality's Traffic and Parking By-Law must be submitted **in writing** to the Brockton municipal office
- Before these proposed amendments are presented to Council notice of the amendment shall be advertised in at least one edition of the Brockton Buzz which shall be circulated to all residents of the municipality by way of the post office
- Notice of the proposed amendment shall also be posted on the municipal website for at least two (2) weeks
- Notices in the Buzz and on the website shall invite comments **in writing** from the public and the notice will specify a due date for these comments to be submitted to the municipal office
- All notices will also specify the date of the Council meeting when submissions will be presented to Council
- All written comments together with any input from municipal staff shall be presented to Council for consideration and discussion of the proposed amendment during an open session of a Brockton Council meeting
- If the amendment is approved, the Parking and Traffic By-Law will be amended at the next following regular meeting of Council
