

NOTICE OF COMMENCEMENT



THE PROJECT:

The Municipality of Brockton is initiating a Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (Class EA) for a proposed new water booster pumping station in the community of Walkerton. The new pumping station is being investigated to address additional residential and non-residential water needs in the northwestern area of the town. A preliminary location for the proposed pumping station, adjacent to Bruce Road 2, is shown on the included map. It is expected that the Class EA will also investigate the establishment of a new pressure zone, as well as potential connection points between the proposed booster pumping station and the existing water distribution system.

THE ENVIRONMENTAL SCREENING PROCESS:

The planning for this project is following the environmental screening process set out for Schedule B activities under the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment process. The purpose of the screening process is to identify potential environmental impacts associated with the project and to plan for appropriate mitigation of any impacts. The process includes consultation with the public, stakeholders, First Nation and Métis communities, and government review agencies.

PUBLIC INVOLVEMENT:

Public input and comments are invited for incorporation into the planning and design of this project. Initial comments are welcomed and will be received until **August 12, 2019**, at the address listed below. Any comments collected in conjunction with the study, will be maintained on file for use during the project and may be included in project documentation. With the exception of personal information, all comments will become part of the public record.
