## NOTICE OF COMPLETION

**THE PROJECT:** The Municipality of Brockton conducted a Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (Class EA) to investigate options to address additional residential and non-residential water needs in the northwestern area of the Town. **The preferred alternative is the provision of water booster pumping station, adjacent to Bruce Road 2**, as shown on the included map. The new booster pumping station will improve water pressure locally for residential and non-residential users and allow for development of the Walker West subdivision.

**THE ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT PROCESS:** This project, was subject to the Class EA process, and as such, followed the planning process established for Schedule B activities. The purpose of the Class EA process is to identify a preferred solution, identify potential environmental impacts associated with the proposal and to plan for appropriate mitigation of those impacts. The process includes consultation with the public, stakeholders and government review agencies. The environmental assessment process has now been completed. There were no negative impacts identified with the project that could not be mitigated.

**PUBLIC INVOLVEMENT:** The Environmental Screening Report is now available for public review and comment. The Report will be available for public review at the Brockton Municipal Office (100 Scott Street, Walkerton) and on the municipal website ([www.brockton.ca](http://www.brockton.ca)).
