Guidelines for Outdoor Vending

Under By-Law 2021-085

Municipality of Brockton

These guidelines are designated to assist persons applying for permission to vend from a vehicle, cart or stand at specific locations in the Municipality of Brockton.

- a) Applications for approval must be submitted to the Brockton Municipal Office
- b) The selection of the location is entirely up to the application on a first come first served basis and Council will determine whether the location is appropriate;
- c) Outdoor vending is prohibited form within residentially zoned areas of the town. When reviewing request for locations near residential zoned areas, Council will consider the potential disruption to the residential area and will deny requests for locations where any potential for residential disruption exists;
- Outdoor vending from parking lot shall not interfere with this normal movement of pedestrians and sales are not permitted from or on the traveled portion of a highway;
- e) Vendors will not be permitted in front of building entrances/exits, names or numbers, standpipes, display windows or fire hydrants;
- f) Vendors vehicle/cart/stand will not interfere with the visibility of pedestrian and vehicles;
- g) The maximum area permitted for carts or stand will be 2.32 metres (25.0 square feet, and the space will include the seats and waste receptacles(s).);
- h) All food vendor application will be accompanied by details of waste receptacles, food storage area, heating, cooling or other equipment as required y the Medical Officer of Health and Inspection thereof;
- Applicants whose vending involves propane or other fuel heaters require an inspection of the vehicle/cart/stand by the Fuel Safety Branch, Technical Standards Division;
- j) The applicants has the right to appear before Council;
- k) Prior to issuance of license, you will be required to submit a certificate of general liability insurance in the amount of \$1,000,000 containing a cross-liability clause naming the Municipality of Brockton as an additional named insured;
- I) Requisite fees as outlined in the Municipal Fees and Charges By-Law must accompany the application and will be refunded if the application is not approved;
- m) On issuance of a license you are free to vend in your approved location in accordance with the provisions of By-Law 2021-085;
- n) The license will be issued for a one (1) year period and all licenses shall expire on December 31st of each year. Each licensee shall have thirty (30) days from the expiration date to renew the license for the same location.
