


Brockton became my home in 2015. My husband and I chose to make our lives here, contribute in meaningful ways, build lasting bonds, and advocate for the community's ongoing vitality.

I am the candidate to choose.

I am community minded, consistently working towards strengthening community bonds, I deeply value family and community connections and I believe that strong relationships and partnerships are the foundation of a thriving, supportive environment. I embody these principles by fostering equity, diversity, and opportunity for all.
