

Notice of the Adoption of Walkerton Official Plan

Take Notice that the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Brockton, having held a Public Meeting December 17, 2025, under Section 17 (15) of the *Planning Act*, has passed **By-Law 2026-008** to adopt a new **Official Plan for the Walkerton Urban Settlement Area** and to repeal the **previously approved Official Plan for Walkerton** on the 13th day of January, 2026. This is the culmination of the Municipality's Official Plan Review.

The Official Plan affects all lands with the Walkerton Settlement Area as illustrated on the below key map.



The Purpose and Effect of the Official Plan

The purpose of Official Plan is to implement the recommendations of the Municipality's conformity review exercise to update Council and community priorities with respect to growth and development within Walkerton, bring the Walkerton Official Plan in conformity with the Provincial Planning Statement 2024 and the Bruce County Official Plan. Written agency comments received prior to council's adoption have been considered and incorporated into the Official Plan. No oral or written public comments were received.

Be Advised That the Municipality of Brockton will be forwarding the Official Plan to the Bruce County Planning and Development Department (as the approval authority) for its review. If deemed appropriate, the County may approve the Official Plan, or may approve it with modifications to ensure conformity with the County of Bruce Official Plan. Supporting materials regarding the Official Plan will also be forwarded to the County. Any person or public body will be entitled to receive notice of the decision of the approval authority if a written request to be notified of its decision (including the person's or public body's address) is made to the approval authority at:
