Now therefore the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Brockton pursuant to Section 34 of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, enacts as follows:


- That By-Law No. 2013-26, as amended, is hereby further amended by changing the zoning symbol that applies to BRANT CON 1 NDR PT LOT 32; PLAN 162 PT PARK LOT 48 RP; 3R9987 PT PART 1, [No Civic Address], Town of Walkerton, Municipality of Brockton, from R2 – Low Density Multiple to R2 – Low Density Multiple and R3 – Residential Medium Density, as shown on Schedule 'A' attached to and forming part of this by-law.
- 2. That this By-law shall come into force and effect on the final passing thereof by the Council of the Municipality of Brockton, subject to compliance with the provisions of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, c.P.13, as amended.
- 3. This By-law may be cited as the "Zoning Amendment By-Law Brockton (Bruce County Housing Corporation) Z-2025-057"


